■ Serving a State or Local Government Officer in His or Her Individual Capacity, Official Capacity, or Both

If you are a plaintiff and you have filed a Complaint, you must arrange for delivery of a copy of the Summons and Complaint to each defendant in your case. This is called "service of process." However, a plaintiff cannot serve the Summons and Complaint. The person who serves the Summons and Complaint (the "server") must be at least 18 years old and not a party to the lawsuit. Your server can serve a defendant that is a state or local government official in his or her individual capacity, official capacity, or both according to the same rules that apply for serving any other individual. Your server can serve the defendant by doing any one of the following:

1. Hand deliver the Summons and Complaint to the defendant.



2. Hand deliver the Summons and Complaint to a responsible person living at the defendant's home.



3. **If your server has made three attempts at hand delivery,** your server may leave the Summons and Complaint at the **defendant's usual place of business** with somebody in charge who is at least 18 years old. At that time, your server must tell the person that the papers are a Summons and Complaint for the defendant. The server must then mail a second copy of the Summons and Complaint to the defendant at the address where the papers were left.

4. **If the defendant is located outside of California, but within the U.S.,** your server may mail the Summons and Complaint to the defendant by <u>certified mail, return receipt</u> <u>requested</u>. If your server chooses this option, you must attach the signed return receipt to the proof of service.

Because serving the Summons and Complaint can be complicated, please read Rule 4 of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure and consider consulting an attorney.

DON'T FORGET!

You must file **a proof of service form** signed by the server (see attached form) so the court knows that you served the right defendant.
