■ Serving the United States

If you are a plaintiff and you have filed a Complaint, you must arrange for delivery of a copy of the Summons and Complaint to each defendant in your case. This is called "service of process." However, a plaintiff cannot serve the Summons and Complaint. The person who serves the Summons and Complaint (the "server") must be at least 18 years old and not a party to the lawsuit. To serve the United States when it is the defendant in a lawsuit filed in the U.S. District Court for the Central District of California, your server must do each of the following:

1. Mail a copy of the Summons and Complaint to the U.S. Attorney for the Central District of California. Your server must send a copy of the Summons and Complaint by <u>certified mail,</u> return receipt requested, to the following address:

2. Mail a copy of the Summons and Complaint to the Attorney General of the United States in Washington, D.C. Your server must send a copy of the Summons and Complaint by <u>certified</u> mail, return receipt requested to the following address:

3. If you are challenging the orders of a federal agency or a federal officer, your server must mail the agency or officer a copy of the Summons and Complaint. Your server must send a copy of the Summons and Complaint to the agency or officer by <u>certified mail</u>, return receipt requested.

Because serving the Summons and Complaint can be complicated, please read Rule 4 of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure and consider consulting an attorney.

DON'T FORGET!

You must file **a proof of service form** signed by the server (see attached form) so the court knows that you served the right defendant.



Certified Mail Receipt






Domestic Return Receipt (Front and Back)
