Emergency Cash Assistance

FEMA: Critical Needs Assistance for individuals displaced from their primary dwelling for minimum of 7 days

- TYPE OF RELIEF: one time \$770 payment; must submit Application to FEMA
- DEADLINE: apply within 60 days following presidential declaration
- Where to Apply:

 - Call the FEMA Helpline: 800-621-3362
 - o In person at a Disaster Recovery Center

Inclusive Action: Open Air Worker Emergency Fund for outdoor workers (street vendors, landscapers, recyclers)

- DEADLINE: JANUARY 17TH 2025 (Application may re-open should more funds become available. Call (213) 435-1151 or email <u>info@inclusiveaction.org</u> for more information)
- **Eligibility**: Must live or work in areas directly impacted by the fires, primarily work outdoors, or have experienced a loss of income/property/belongings due to fires
