**MODIFIED PERMANENT
INJUNCTION**

1 On April 6, 2026, the Court **GRANTED** Plaintiffs' Cross-Motion to Modify
2 Injunction (Docket No. 269).

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4 Pursuant to Rules 60 and 65 of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure, the
5 Permanent Injunction entered in this action on September 30, 1985 (reported at 619
6 F. Supp. 656) is **MODIFIED** as follows:

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8 Defendant United States Department of Homeland Security and its officers,
9 agents, servants, employees, and attorneys, and other persons in active concert or
10 participation with them, are **ENJOINED** from providing the UAC Processing
11 Pathway Advisal, in written or oral form, on its own or in combination with Form I-
12 770, to any class member in their custody.

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14 This modification takes effect in addition to the terms identified in the
15 Court's previous Order Re Advisal, filed in this action on May 16, 1986. (Docket
16 No. 240). Pursuant to that Order, Defendants shall comply with the Order of the
17 Court reported at 619 F. Supp. 656, 670, as supplemented by the Order of February
18 20, 1986 (Docket No. 232), and the Order Re Advisal.
